COMMANDER JOHN MANSON R.N.

It was with great sadness that I recently heard of the death of John Manson, late of this Parish.

John joined the Navy as a young man, and quickly rose through the ranks. He served on ships such as the large aircraft carrier H.M.S. Albion, and had a spell as landing deck officer.

He once told me that it was a very frightening job, especially at night time. He then transferred to submarines, and eventually ended up as chief engineer in the nuclear submarine HMS Dreadnought. After several years of service he travelled to Dounreay in 1969 and took up a post as second in command on HMS Vulcan, helping to develop and improve nuclear propelled engines, for the new breed of submarines. He stayed there until 1971, he then transferred to Bath where the Admiralty was. He and his wife Eve and two children settled in Priston, after years of moving they at long last had a base. Not long after, he left the Admiralty to work in the private sector of ship building. They moved to Dunkerton in 1976, to Church House. Soon after this, they both joined the Parish Council, with Eve as Clerk. John became Chairman in 1989 and continued until he resigned in 2001.

Eve continued as Clerk for one more year and then she resigned as they left the village to settle in Bath.

John and Eve were first class Chairman and Clerk and we were very grateful for their years of service.

They were both certainly great assets to the village.

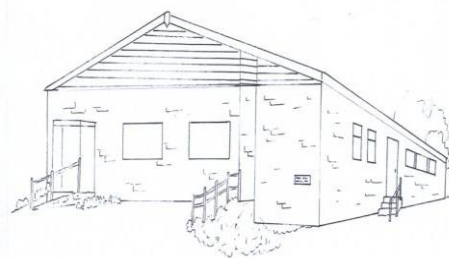

Update on Rural Transport from David Orme


At the public meeting in the TRC on the 10th Jan to discuss the problems around the bus service through Tunley I reported that there was an intent in BANES to create a Rural Transport Partnership Group. The idea was that such a new group would be able to get bus service providers, bus users and BANES officers together in discussion so that, in future, things like the allocation of subsidies by BANES to First Bus (to keep unprofitable rural services running) would be done with a better understanding of the impact of cuts. At the moment, it seems decisions are taken on a crude measure that doesn't recognise the greater value of bus services through rural villages. As a month has gone by since that meeting I thought it right to offer an update on progress.

Since the 10th Jan, Cllr Paul Myers (BANES Council Cabinet Member for Economic and Community Regeneration) has been contacting those whose support will be vital if the new Group is going to work and to do any good. This work behind the scenes is now coming to an end and it is likely that the new Group will be given the go ahead to the Parishes' Liaison Meeting (a regular meeting between BANES and local Parish Councils) on the 6th March. Shortly after that we might hope that the Group will put a plan together that can be published in Parish newsletters like The Batch, so we can all see what is going to be done to improve rural transport.

It needs emphasising that none of this is trying to stop, or avoid, or dilute any of the action that is being taken by local campaigners to restore the 179 service. Rather the opposite – the idea is to get everyone to understand (and perhaps not everyone does) why the 179 issue has raised so much justifiable concern along the whole of the Cam Valley, and to underline the urgency of getting something sorted by August this year when, if nothing changes, the BANES subsidy for the service runs out and it could be lost altogether.

More news as it happens.
